About the Organization

Sparsh Educational & Healthcare Society is a secular, grass root non-government and nonprofit making organization established in the year 2011. It is registered under Indian Societies Registration Act XXI of 1860. It is formed to promote and enhance sustainable rural, tribal and urban development and to create opportunities to the vulnerable and disadvantage sections of the DALIT community comprising of Scheduled Caste and Scheduled Tribes, In order to enhance their socio-economic status. Since its inception the organization have conducted various activities in Mayurbhanj District, Odisha.

Sparsh Educational & Healthcare Society believes in the integrated approach, participatory planning, demonstration, exposure visits, empowerment and capacity building for the project implementations considering the community decision as final.

Like all previous years this year also we have taken up the following activities and completed some and continuing some.

1). Eye / Health camps:

On 21-07-2013, Under the head of this program we have conducted Eye Camps in coordination with the District Medical and Health Department. Nearly 73 old age people were benefited under this program.

We have conducted Health Camps arranging minor surgeries for piles, butts etc. We have identified chronic diseases patients and referred to concerned hospitals for Treatment. And for normal a seasonal diseases we have distributed medicines free of cost. We have organized Medical and Health Camps for old age, women including children. At our targeted villages and propagated the importance of balanced nutritious diet for the good health of children at our targeted areas of Mayurbhanj district of Odisha.

2). Non-formal Education:

On 05-11-2013, under the head of this activity we have conducted Non Formal Education for street children in Jaipur panchayat of Mayurbhanj District of Odisha. Nearly 85 students were benefited. These children who were abandoned by the families need to be stimulated by the staff and occupy them with something so that they do not think of past situation. Therefore, the non-formal education program plays vital role in changing that situation. Recreational activities i.e. playing, watching TV, listening to music is also encouraged. A phenomenon of street children is a growing urban problem. As a result of unplanned and rapid growth in the urban areas millions of families migrate to the cities in search of green pastures.

3). CONSUMER AWARENESS PROGRAM:

On 15-09-2013, in Badra Village of Mayurbhanj Dist, under the head of this program we have conducted Consumer Awareness on Consumer activities, redresses three tier system, and also awareness on consumer right etc. We also created awareness on ISI, Agamark, . Hall Mark, Silk Mark, Eco Products etc. The differences between Guarantee and Warrantee and also in Warrantee there are replacement Warrantee and Warrantee on parts only. Nearly 62 people were benefited under this program



4). Assistance to Adult Education Program:

On 18-10-2013, The organization is conducting adult education program to the uneducated in the village Churu in Mayurbhanj district of Odisha.



5) . HIV / AIDS AWARENESS PROGRAM :

On 01-12-2013, in Jashipur, we conducted an awareness programs on HIV / AIDS. As the disease has no cure, the public must have awareness how to avoid the AIDS with precautionary measures. Hence, we awakening the public through public meetings, film shows etc., media. We also distributing Rice Dhall etc., food grains to the AID who can't afford food from their sources.
